#### Founder and CEO ShelterBox - Tom Henderson

The ShelterBox concept was thought up and developed by Rotarian and ex-Royal Navy search-and-rescue diver Tom Henderson. Without protection from the elements survival can be a real battle – particularly for the young, old and infirm. ShelterBox was launched in April 2000 with the first 143 ShelterBoxes flown to the earthquake-hit region of Gujarat in India in January 2001. Now, ShelterBox has become one of the most effective aid agencies in the world.

##### Roger Cram

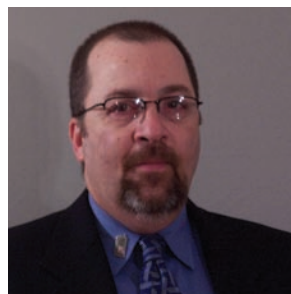
Roger researched for five years “how” the famed Tuskegee Airmen, the first black US military pilots, solved their almost insurmountable problems peacefully.
