YOUTH PROTECTION COMMITTEE UPDATE

There are 3 distinct functions performed by this committee:

1-Youth Exchange

The designated youth exchange committee member should run background(BC) checks on host families club YEO & YEC for clubs hosting a student. The fees for this should be part of the fees the clubs already have paid to host a student. Copies of the affidavits and BC should be provided to whoever is doing the club certification. If for some reason the club has not submitted Continuing Support of the District Youth Protection policy, this can be obtained by the youth exchange committee.

2-Club Compliance/Certification

The committee member designated should get the club compliance form updated each year, these are given to the president-elect at PETS. Run criminal background checks on the club members working with youth, when the clubs send in their requests. Keep a list of the clubs and members that have been checked and provide an updated copy to the DG each month, if there are updates. This individual would also keep the club files up to date.

3-Training

Providing training for those working with youth. in accordance with the district youth protection policy.

Volunteer affidavits should be valid until the information on them changes. Address changes, name changes, employment changes all would require a new document.

In order for clubs to be in compliance they must have background checks done by the district youth protection committee.
