

YOUR ROTARY BLAZER

Your Rotary blazer is the one item of clothing that is an absolute necessity for your Rotary Youth Exchange. You will wear it at Rotary functions here in the United States of America before and after you leave our country, and you will wear it at Rotary functions in your host country.

The blazer is a dark navy blue, classic blazer made out of any durable fabric that fits you comfortably and will last through your year abroad.

You purchase your own Rotary blazer on your own. Rotary doesn't give you the blazer.

You may purchase your blazer anywhere you would like, and you may pay as little or as much as you wish for the blazer. Students often buy their blazers from retailers such as Kohl's, Macy's or The Boston Store. You may buy great, second-hand blazers from Goodwill, Salvation Army, St. Vincent De Paul, or any other "thrift" or "re sale" shop. Your blazer is going to be covered, hopefully, with pins and memorabilia that you trade with other exchange students and friends that you meet, so you will see very little of the surface of this blazer by the time you return to the United States of America. So, it does not have to be fancy.
