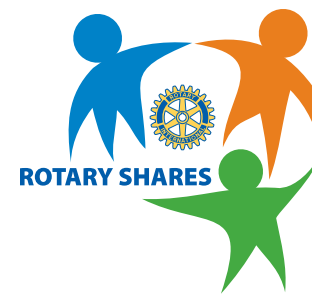

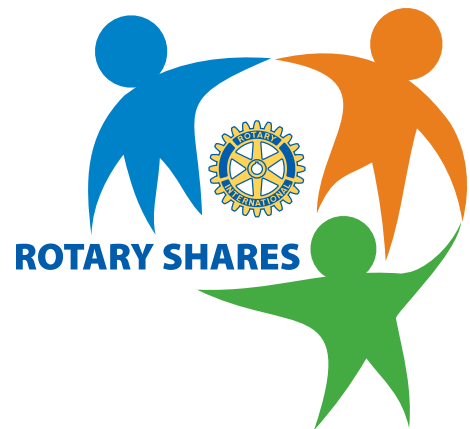

NASA Engineer**

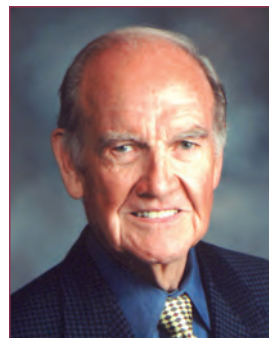
“Rotary’s Role in Successful Overseas Projects.”

A former presidential candidate and U.S. Senator from South Dakota, George McGovern was elected to the U.S. House of Representatives in 1956 and 1958. He was appointed by President John F. Kennedy to serve as the U.S. Food for Peace Director in 1960 and then served as U.S. Senator for South Dakota from 1962 to 1980. He was awarded the Presidential Medal of Freedom – the nation’s highest civilian award.

From Chicago and vicinity: Take I-94 north to Highway 50 Kenosha/Lake Geneva west. Proceed west approximately 26 miles. Resort is on your right.

From Madison: Take I-90 south to Beloit and Janesville, then take Delevan exit Highway 11 south of Janesville. In Delevan, take Highway 50 and proceed through Lake Geneva heading east. Resort is on your left.

From Milwaukee: Take I-894 and I-43 south to Elkhorn and exit at Highway 12/Lake Geneva exit. Follow Highway 12 to Highway 50 East/Lake Geneva exit (second exit). Take off-ramp and continue east, going under the overpass. Resort is on your left.
