

# District 6270 Simplified Grants

## Overview

The District 6270 Simplified Grant (DSG) process is administered by the Grants/World Community Service Committee of the District, which is part of the larger Foundation Committee. In the 2009-2010 Rotary year, District 6270 will receive \$27,684 for these grants. This grant process provides clubs with an opportunity to accomplish humanitarian projects on the local, national or international level. All grants must meet the standards of the RI Humanitarian Grant Guidelines. All on time submitted grants will be considered for funding.

## Grant Requirements

- Projects should be well planned and of scope that will be accomplished within the Rotary year. Grants are not awarded to continuing projects. Must have a NEW feature.
- ACTIVE Rotarian participation in the project is required. (Hands on.)
- If awarded a DSG, two progress reports are required in November and in April, with a final written report to be submitted by May 30, 2010.
- Preference will be given to applying clubs that have contributed to RI Foundation Annual Program Fund -- Every Rotarian Every Year "EREY"
- Grants are limited to one per club per year, addressing a humanitarian need. See attached listing for eligible and ineligible projects.
- Grant applications must be submitted by the district deadline application date of June 1, 2009.
- Clubs not meeting the reporting requirement in a previous year will not be considered in the current cycle.

## Application Process

Complete the District 6270 Simplified Grant Application by due date of June 1, 2009.

The primary contact should be the 2009-2010 Club President, the secondary contact can be any Rotary club member involved in this project. BOTH contacts will be responsible for overseeing the project and completing the required progress and final reports. The DSG application is signed by the current Rotary Club 2008 – 2009 President.
