Nancy gave a short travelogue about their "Rotary Safari" to South Africa and Swaziland. They visited an orphanage in Swaziland started by PDG Rick Luedke's classmate District Governor. During the business portion of the meeting, DG Bill announced that the Fox Cities Neenah Rotary Club has been officially chartered by Rotary International. District 6270 now has 60 clubs. The Fox Cities club will have a charter event sometime in September of 2010. After the treasurer's report, the Executive Committee approved sending \$4,177 dollars to the District 6270 Haiti Water Collection Project. This money had been collected at the 2009 PETS in Appleton, WI. It was originally collected for a wheelchair project in Nigeria, but the PETS chair was not able to successfully get the money to the project. The Haiti Water Collection Project collects rain water for people in Haiti that otherwise would not have fresh water because of the massive earthquake. The District hopes to get enough money to build at least 100 of these water collection devices. Foundation Chair Bob Nolan reported that for this year so far, D6270 clubs have contributed \$181,748 to the Annual Fund and \$88,563 to the Restricted Fund (mostly for polio). This figure of \$221,000 for the district so far is outstanding remarked DG Bill, especially in the weak economy. Bob Nolan also reported that for 2010-11, there will be \$23,365 available for district simplified grants.

The next Executive Committee meeting will be on August 25, 2010 at M.J. Stevens. The meeting will begin at 2pm to discuss the District 6270 Strategic Plan.
