

Rotary Vision Facilitation Information sheet for Rotary Clubs

Trained facilitators are ready to guide your Rotary Club with a Visioning facilitation process. This is not a District or a RI program. This is a process of club members visioning for the club.

It is required that the current Club President, the President Elect, the President Elect Nominee and other club officers agree to engage and commit to this process. This process asks that all participants think outside the box. All Rotarians are of equal voice regardless of tenure in Rotary.

Club participation expectation: Rotary Club of less than 30 members than must have $\frac{3}{4}$'s of members at facilitation. If club is over 30 members than need 25-30 participants at facilitation. Participants must include a cross section of your membership – including the newest members, men and women, cultural diversity, etc.

Steps to getting started to hold a Rotary Club Vision Facilitation Process:

1. Club leadership agrees to do the Rotary Visioning process and is committed to support results.
2. Contact the Vision Facilitation Coordinator – Nancy Rhodes -- nrhodes@milwpc.com or (414) 964-4055. This is to get into the queue for Vision Facilitation.
3. Determine the club contact person to coordinate/setup the event. Share info with Nancy.
4. Select date with optional alternative dates for the club. Includes site location, supplies and meal. Share with Nancy.
5. Promote event within Rotary Club to insure participation from a cross section of club Rotarians. Visioning event will be cancelled if minimal participation is indicated.

Supplies the club does need to furnish for the Vision facilitation.

2 pads of Post it flip-chart paper (newsprint size)
Package of $\frac{3}{4}$ " blue or black dots
Package of $\frac{3}{4}$ " red or orange dots
Flip chart markers (2 sets of black, blue, & red)
Meal for club members and Vision Facilitator Team (3-4 people)

Room Setup needs:

Room – large enough for U-Shape seating for club participants around outside of the U-shape
Power cord with power strip
Projection screen
2 easels to hold the flip chart paper
